Friday, April 5th – 3-5th grade Math part two.

Tuesday, April 9th – 3-5th grade ELA part two.

April 10th-12th Make ups.

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Attendance is vital. There is a direct connection between attendance and success in the classroom. When students are not at school, they are missing instruction. We understand that emergencies come up. Therefore, students need to be at school every day when they are not sick. Instruction begins at 8:30am, the second bell. If students arrive after this time, they need to be signed in at the front office.
