ATTENTION – 5th grade families. It is time to make a decision on your middle school. Time is running out for the first round of placements. TUSD has many options depending on the experience you are looking for. Myers-Ganoung home school is Roberts-Naylor. If you want to attend a school that is not your home school, an Open Enrollment form is needed. You can do this at: https://applytusd1.org/login. Magnet schools, require the open enrollment process. Traditionally, magnet schools provide transportation. Other schools, out of your home school area, will not provide transportation, even though it is through the open enrollment process. However, the sooner you decide, the more likely it is that you will get the school of your choice. (Cont'd ->)
